

This notice is being given to you to satisfy any obligation that NAL Worldwide, LLC ("NAL") may have under the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 (the "WARN Act"). The WARN Act requires that employers give official notice to certain government units or officials of a pending plant closing or mass layoff.

One or more operating units located at NAL's location at 1551 Perry Road, Plainfield, Indiana will cease production or work. The closing of these operating units is the result of the customer ceasing activity at this location. NAL expects that the separation of employees who will experience an employment loss as a consequence of the discontinuation of these operating units will commence on March 31, 2010 or within the fourteen days thereafter. It is anticipated that approximately 126 employees may be affected by this plant closing. Attached to this notice is a list of the titles of positions affected and the number of affected employees in each position. Affected employees do not have any "bumping" rights. None of the affected employees are represented by a union.

While certain employees may be offered the opportunity to transfer to another operating unit within the company, it is unknown at this time which, if any, employees may be offered this option.
