Indiana Native American Indian Affairs Commission (INAIAC) to host town hall meeting in Indianapolis

INDIANAPOLIS (October 26, 2007) – The Indiana Native American Indian Affairs Commission (INAIAC) will hold a town hall meeting in Indianapolis on Saturday, November 10 at the American Indian Center of Indiana. The Center is located in the John H. Boner Community Center, 2236 E. 10th Street, in Indianapolis.

The town hall meeting will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon, and is open to the public.

The Commission, which was established by the Indiana General Assembly, advises state government officials on American Indian issues in the areas of employment, education, civil rights, health, and housing.

“The meeting will begin with an introduction and a brief explanation of the history of the commission and its accomplishments. There will be a brief synopsis of current and future projects,” said Brian Buchanan, chair of the commission and principal chief of the Miami Nation of Indians of Indiana.

"This is an excellent opportunity for the commission to listen and learn about native American needs and concerns," he said.
