H1N1 Flu Clinics for December 15 - 17, 2009 Announced

Lawrenceburg, Indiana --- Dearborn county health officials have scheduled H1N1 Flu Clinics for December 15, 16, and 17, 2009 for the following:

December 15th: pregnant mothers; care providers for children under 6 months old; people with underlying health conditions to age 64; people 10 and older and under 24 years of age; and any health care personnel who may not have received their vaccination. This list is the targeted list as provided by the Indiana State Department of Health.

December 16th : 6 month to 9 year old: First dose, or second dose for those 9 and under who have already received their first dose at either the Lawrenceburg School Clinic or the Sunman Dearborn Intermediate School Clinic (must be at least 28 days apart for the second dose)

December 17th: will be a general population clinic. We will offer it to anyone who wants to receive it even if they are not in a targeted group, or even if they are in a targeted group but did not make it to a clinic before this one. This clinic will be on a first come first serve basis, and while supplies last. The department hopes to have enough vaccine for the allotted time period of the clinic, but this cannot be guaranteed.

All three clinics will be from 1:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m., Agner Hall, Lawrenceburg Fairgrounds, Lawrenceburg, Indiana. Nasal Mist and the injectable “shot” formulations will be available. Nasal mist can be used for any healthy person age 2 -49 years old with no underlying health condition.
