- Stimulus Funds
- \$42,764,321 for Indiana child care
- Obligated by 9/30/10
- Had to be spent by 9/30/11
- Minimum of 4% on Quality
- “Supplement” not “Supplant”

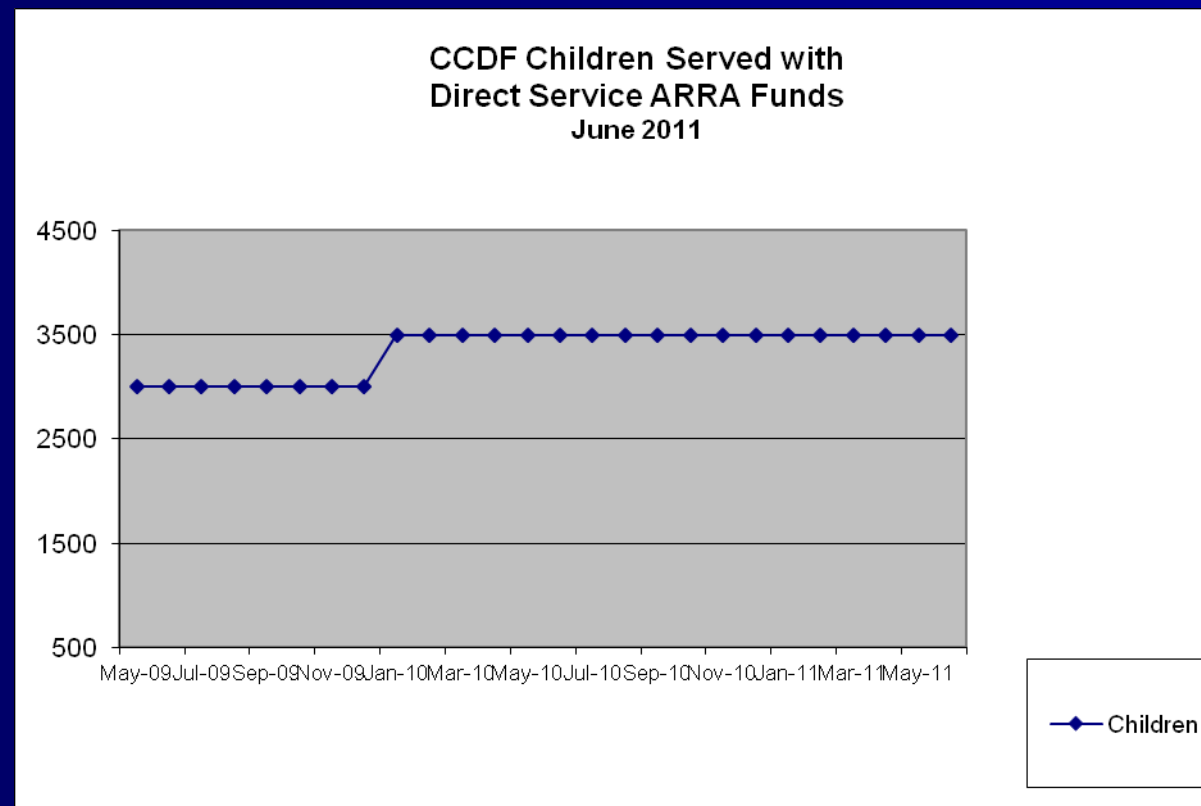
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How'd we do?

- Spent \$42,764,320.94
- Left 6 cents on the table
- Spent 99.999999986% of available funds

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Jobs Created/Retained

- 385 at child care providers to care for additional voucher children.
- 31.25 to administer quality projects.

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Program Supports

Capital Improvements:

- 192 Playground Grants (up to \$5K each)
- 16 Tier III Infant/Toddler capital improvement projects (up to \$15K each)
- Over \$662,000 in United Way funding for Ministry capital improvements in Central Indiana

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Program Supports

- 82 providers received supports on IACCRR's Hoosier Child Care project (valued from \$700 - \$2,000)
- Over 400 providers received supports on the PTQ Level advancement project
- 74 providers received up to \$1,500 in supports for Level II awards on the Infant/Toddler project
