

## It's the right thing and it's the law.

You are **required** to report **abuse and/or neglect.** 

Indiana law (IC 31-33-5-1) requires anyone who suspects child abuse or neglect to report it to the authorities.

If you have **ANY** doubts or suspicions about whether or not to report abuse and/or neglect of a child, call the hotline: 1-800-800-5556



If you work in a child care or youth serving program, you are a Professional Reporter and by law you must report suspected abuse and neglect.

Professionals who knowingly fail to make a report required by IC 31-33-5-2 commit a Class B misdemeanor.

Even if your organization has a policy and a designated reporter, you are still required by Indiana law to make a report yourself in most cases
