TRENDS

Debbie gave an update on trends from 2008. The following statistics were shared with the group:

- As of 12/31/2008, there were 3,053 licensed child care homes for a possible capacity of 37,670.
 Net increase of 31 homes over 2007. There were 481 new class I homes and 103 new class II homes.
- 62 accredited homes (2%).
- 69% of our licensed child care homes have someone living in the home. 31% are used for child care only.
- 43 probationary licenses were issued in 2008
- Cease & Desist letters sent to 10 unlicensed providers. Two were sent to the Attorney General's
 Office to file injunctions to stop them from operating.
- 36 applications were denied and 37 licenses were revoked.
- 583 complaints were investigated
- 1,663 (54%) providers are grandfathered for the educational requirements and 787 providers have completed the educational requirements.
- Top 5 citations for 2008 were:
- 1. Missing annual TB or chest x-ray for providers and all family members over 18.
- 2. Children's records written statement from physician or certified nurse practitioner that says child may participate
- Documentation of current 1st Aid, CPR, or UP
- 4. Enrollment forms
- 5. Children's records up to date immunizations
