  - a) Customer Satisfaction Survey presentation given by Karen Smith
- V. BRS Director's Update
  - a) BRS Director's Update presentation given by Theresa Koleszar
    - VR program growth trends: Number of SFY24 VR applicants, eligibility determinations, and service plans projected to meet or exceed pre-pandemic (SFY19) trends.
    - Order of selection: 588 remaining on waitlist as of February 29; next release April 2024. Still on track to end the order of selection before December.
    - Provider incentive payment update (initial roll-out August 2023): 114 incentive payments authorized and 66 claimed and paid as of February 9, 2024. Total payment value \$56,160 in incentive payments to VR providers. Initiating an evaluation through a contract with PCG to evaluate effectiveness of performance incentive payments over the next two years.



- State Plan: public comment period closed February 22; received comments on three topic areas including a need to prioritize workforce needs for mental health services, addressing transportation barriers, and streamlining of pre-ets referrals. Responses were provided for all comments. State plan was submitted.
- VR Draft Rules
  - 1. Alignment with Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, including incorporation of pre-employment transition services and provision of youth extended services
  - 2. Alignment with practice changes implemented as a result of prior audits including 2017 federal monitoring, specifically vendor rule that addresses VR vendor registration and claims payments
  - 3. Incorporation of feedback gathered from stakeholders, including better organization and clarity
- Rules to be posted March 20<sup>th</sup> for public comment, with public hearing April 22.
