What is the timeframe for individuals to transition to an awarded case management company?

Individuals and guardians must choose an awarded case management no later than December 14, 2021. Implementation begins January 1, 2022.

How does this affect submissions of budgets or budget modification requests?

All activities related to the individual's services and service plan are tied to the individual. All typical processes and timelines remain and still exist.

How will I be notified of an individual's CMCO change?

Providers will receive a new Notice of Action when a CMCO changes.

What is the timeline for changes in the portal?

Where can I find updates?

The BDDS Portal will show changes in the individual's CMCO and/or case manager.

If an individual changes CMCOs, the service plan will be updated and a new Notice of Action issued.
