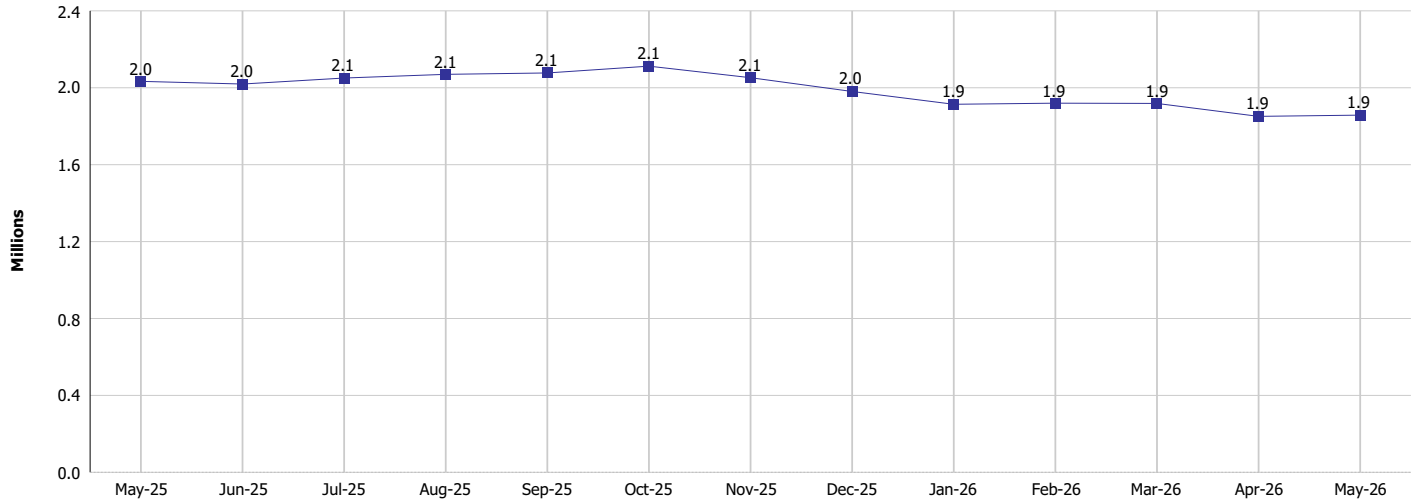

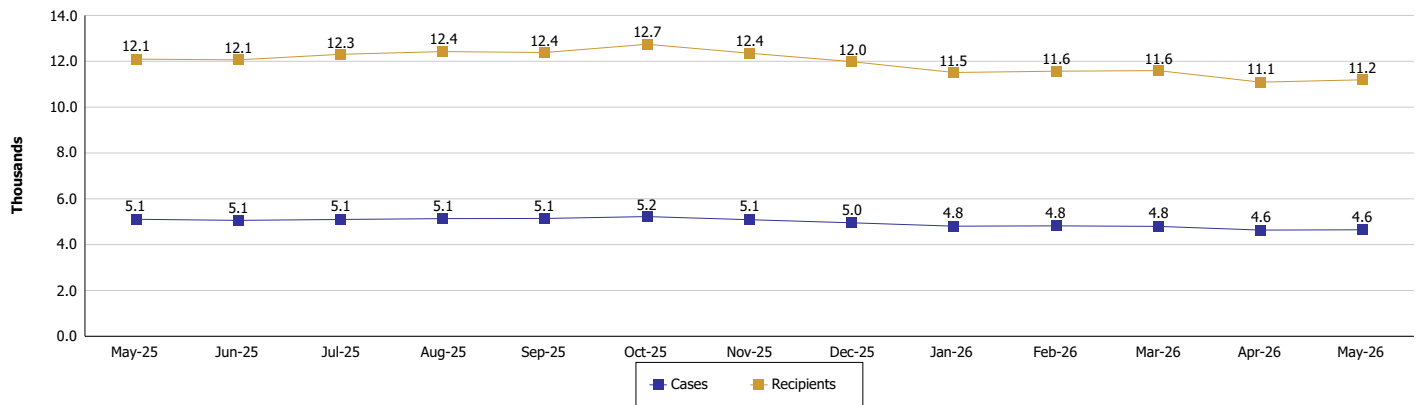
TANF Cash Assistance

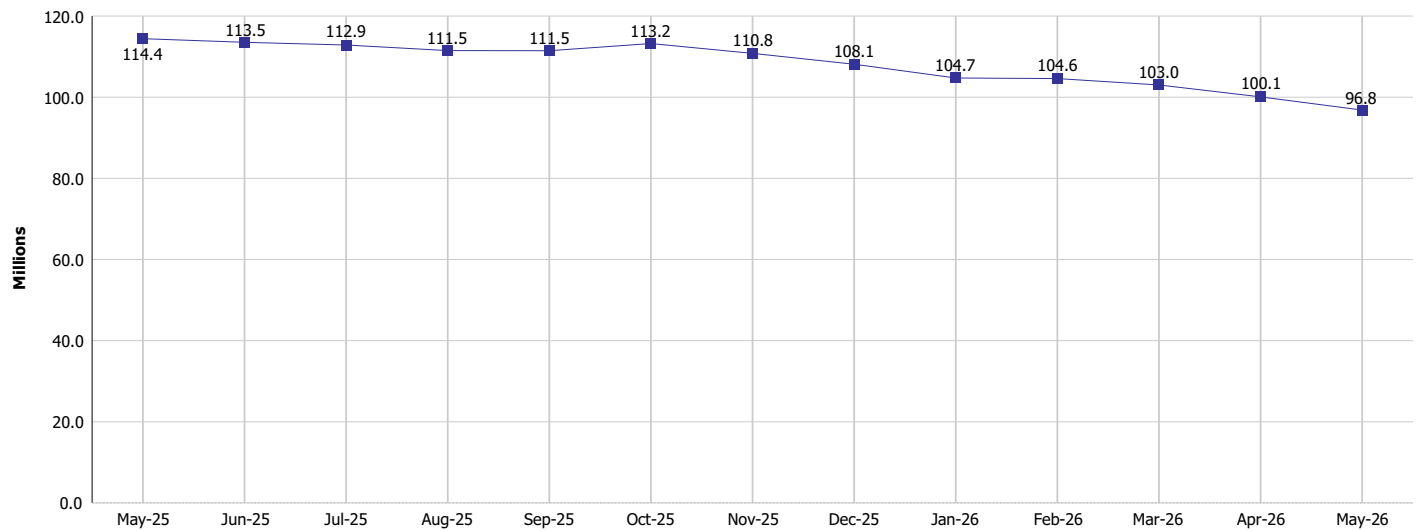

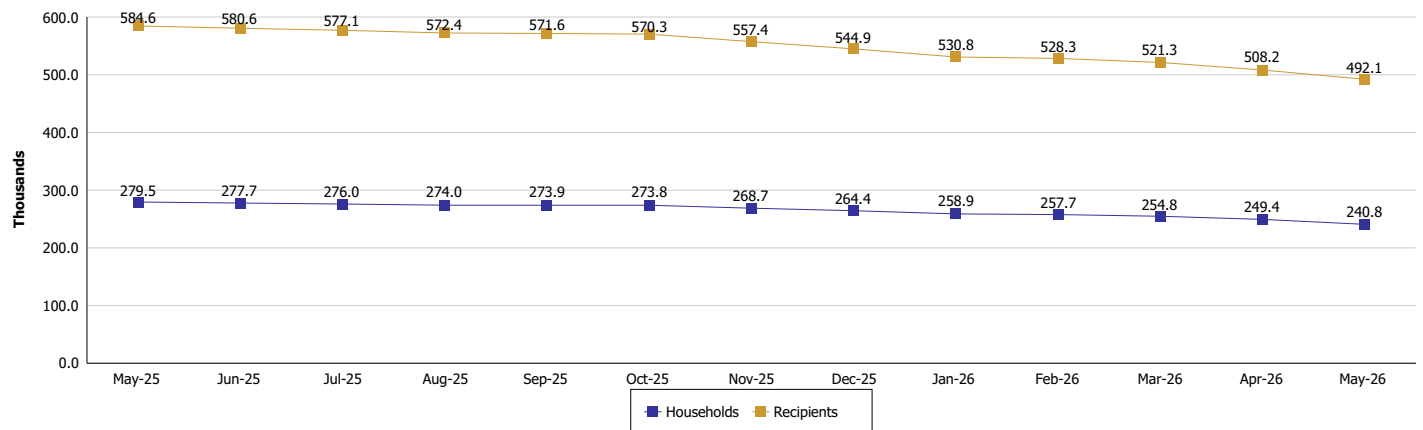
