Should we get rid of almost everything other than a list of the recommendations, perhaps with a sentence or two of context beforehand?</li> <li>Regarding the Mental Health Literacy letter: we attempted to get significant signatures from non-BHC members to bolster support for what has become a controversial topic. We got a few, but probably not a critical mass. I'm thinking it looks clunky in the attached draft as a letter, so should just make it part of the body of the text and note the non-BHC members that supported it as well?</li> <li>I really like the concept of "Wicked Problems" as a framing for the current system. I wasn't sure how it was going to look in the report. I actually think it works, but would like honest feedback on that.</li> <li>Criminal Justice: do the recommendations need to be fleshed out a bit more?</li> <li>In general: is it clear what are recommendations and what are context? Do we need to highlight/flag more explicitly what are actual recommendations?</li> <li>Order: Zoe and I worked on the section labeled "funding"—we think it is pretty good, but does it make sense to go before the body of the report, or is it a nice concluding section?</li> <li>CCBHC appears to be missing, we should make sure it is in there</li> </ol>
