ASAM Criteria 4th Edition Foundations Course Registration is now open for most training dates.

The Indiana Family and Social Services Administration's Division of Mental Health and Addiction, in partnership with Ivy Tech Community College, Purdue University-West Lafayette, Purdue University Northwest, HealthLinc, Community Fairbanks, and IU Health, will offer 9 American Society of Addiction Medicine Criteria 4th Edition Foundations Courses across the state in 2024. Each course will be held from 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. local time and is free of charge to all participants. Maximum capacity for most trainings is 85 people, so please plan accordingly. *Note: The Indianapolis trainings are expected to fill up quickly. Please consider attending one of the training courses in other locations if possible.*
