

**LOGANSPORT STATE HOSPITAL**  
**Facility Fact Sheet for 2015**

Logansport State Hospital (LSH) has served persons with mental illness since 1888. In 1993, a new facility was opened that housed a majority of the patients. In August 2005, the new Isaac Ray Treatment Center was opened with a bed capacity of 105 beds. In 2011, the hospital reduced bed capacity to 170 and staffing in support of the DMHA transition. Logansport State Hospital continues to maintain Joint Commission accreditation.

The hospital is composed of two Service Lines which provide care to adults with mental illness and/or persons who are developmentally disabled. The Service Lines are:

- **Isaac Ray Treatment Center (IRTC):** 88 beds (4 units) The forensic service line serves individuals who are incompetent to stand trial, individuals who have served their sentences with the Department of Correction (DOC) and continue to need mental health services, individuals found not guilty by reason of insanity and those individuals with mental illness and severely dangerous behaviors.
- **Larson (LTC) Continuous Psychiatric Services:** 82 beds (4 units) This service line provides specialty programs of Sexual Responsibility programming, Female Forensic services for those that are incompetent to stand trial or who have served their sentences with the Department of Corrections (DOC) and require additional mental health services. Programs are also provided for individuals who require programming focused on cognitive skill building, step-down and continued stabilization.

Treatment is individualized through interdisciplinary assessments and may include stabilization of symptoms through psychopharmacology, management of medical problems, individual and group therapy, patient and family education, rehabilitation and recreation therapy, academic and skills training, and vocational training including pre-vocational skills. Various types of training programs implement bio-psychosocial learning programs, including groups on medication management, anger management, coping skills, community re-integration, social skills development, and adult living skills such as money management and cooking, etc.
