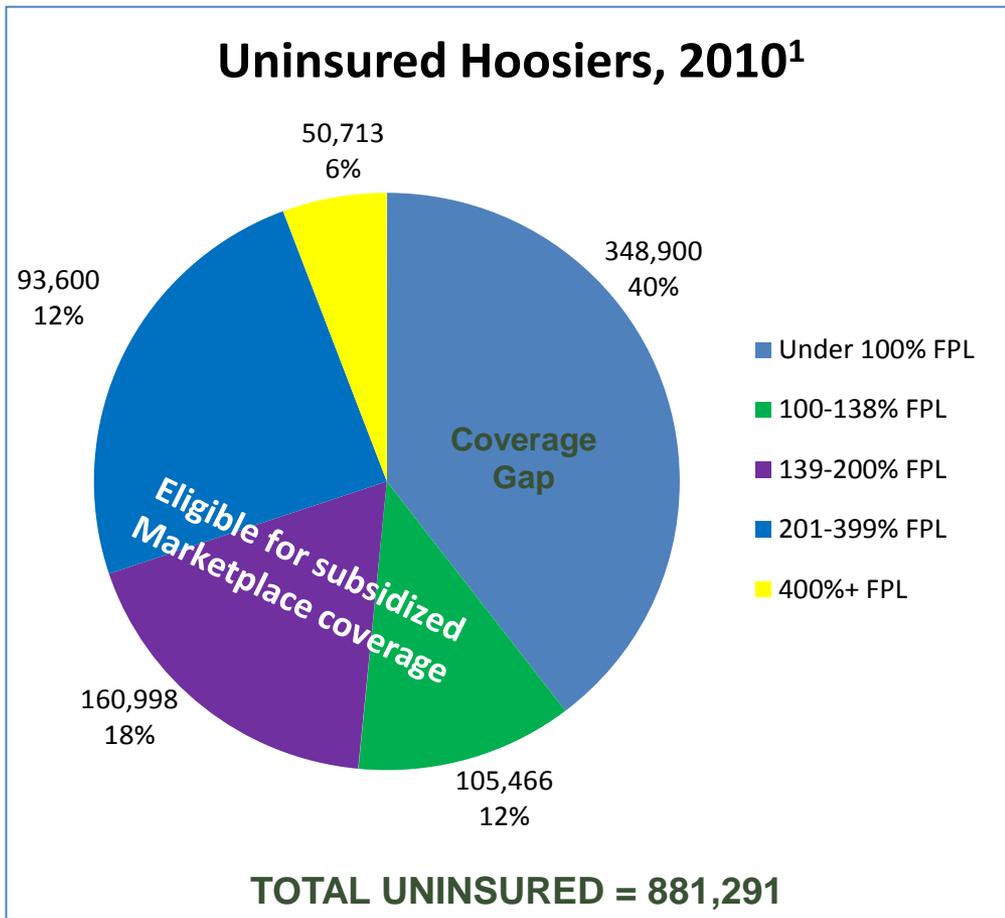

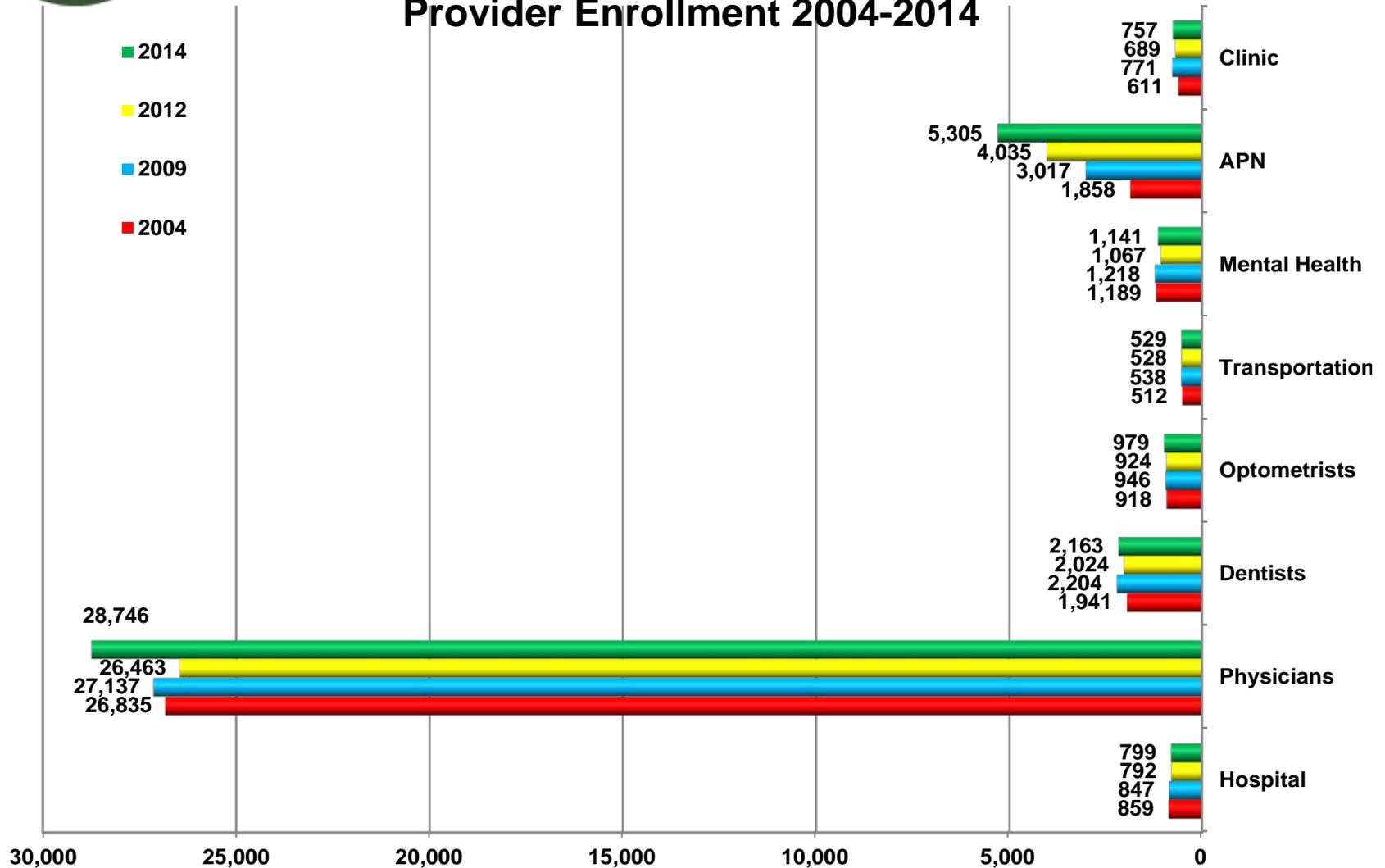

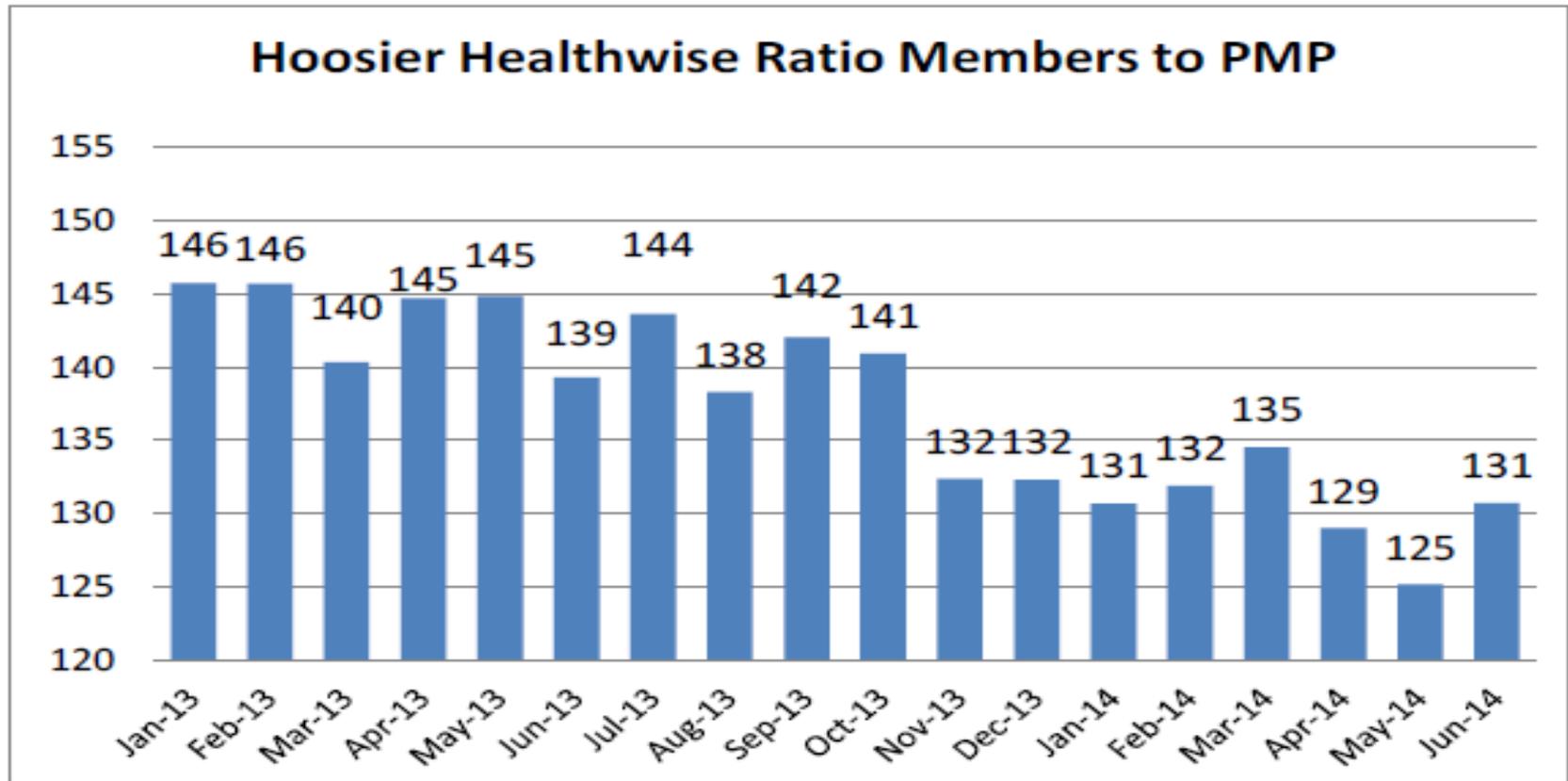

## Provider Enrollment 2004-2014



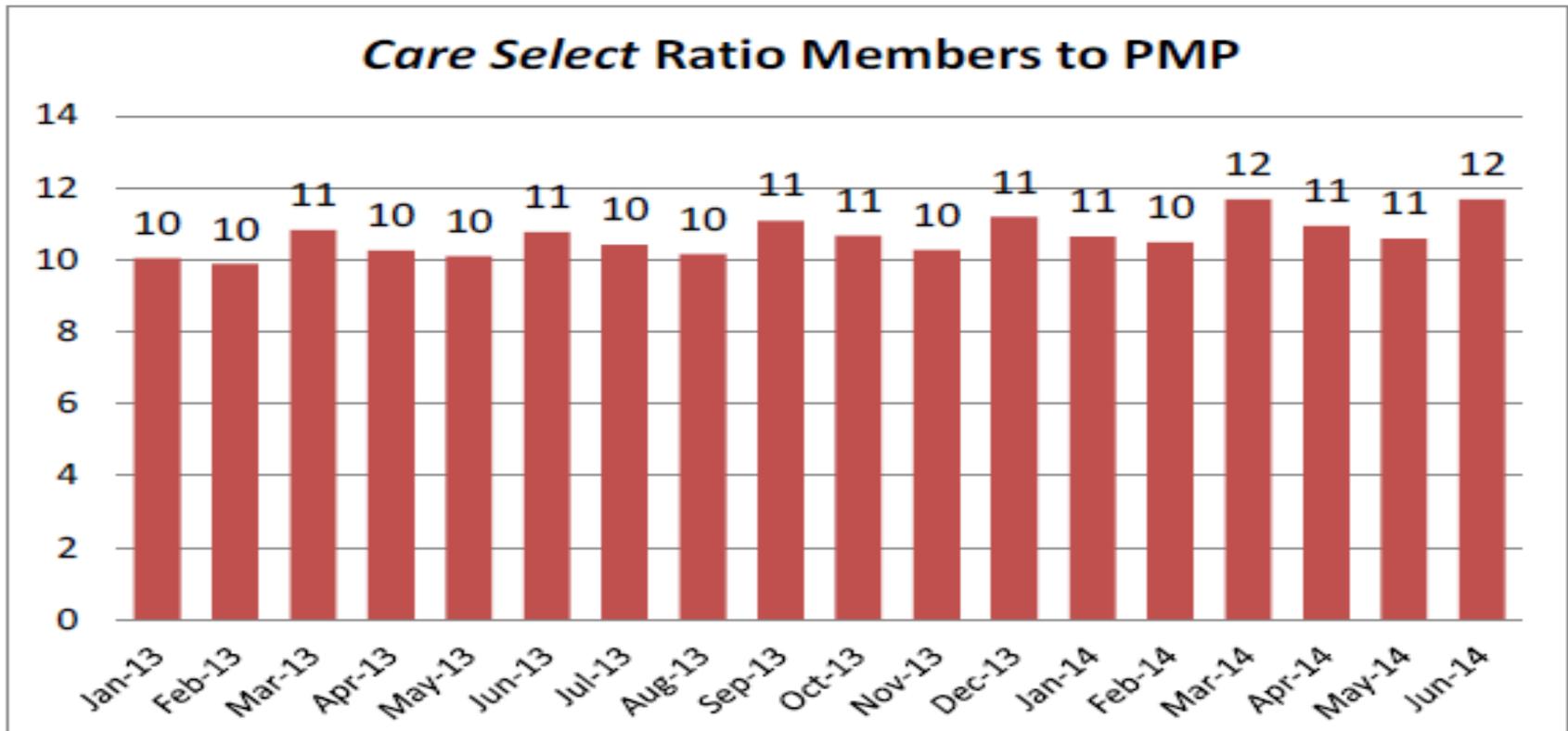

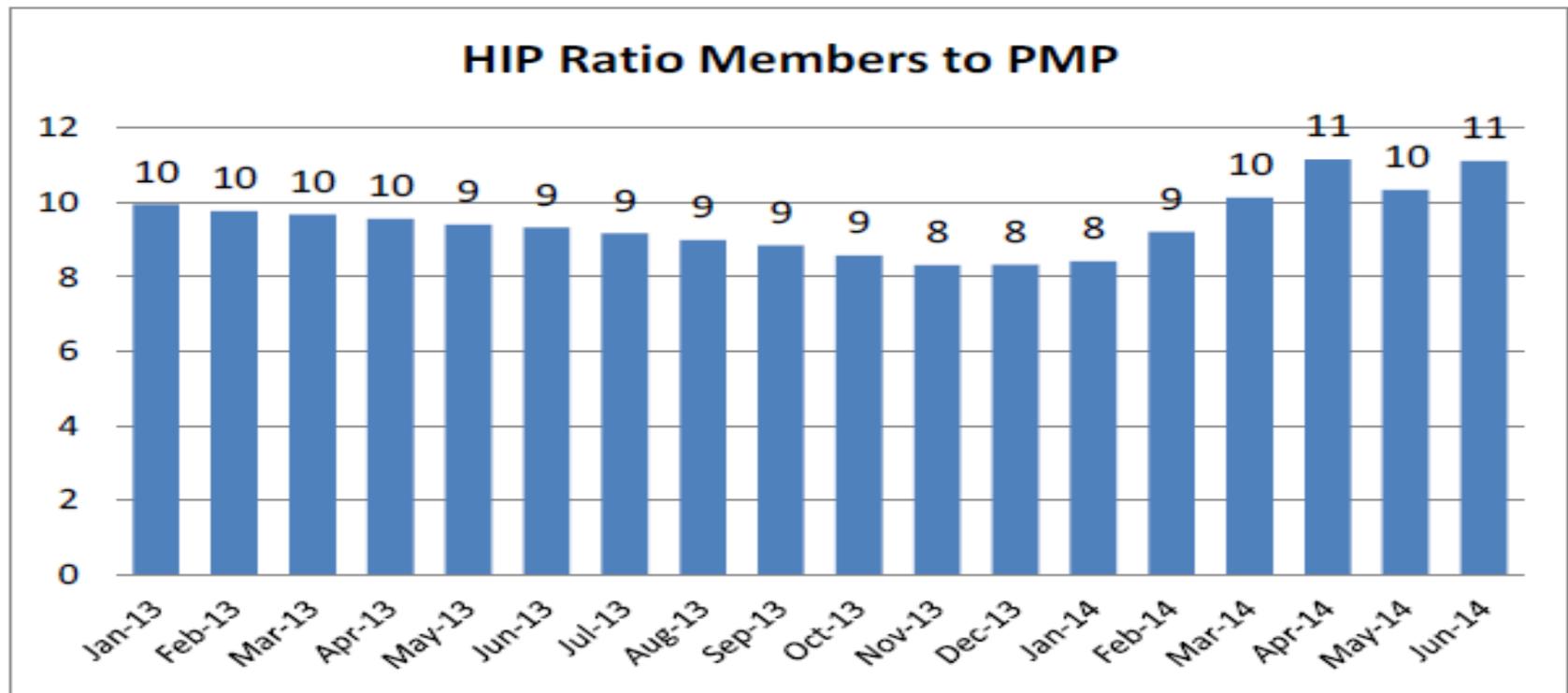

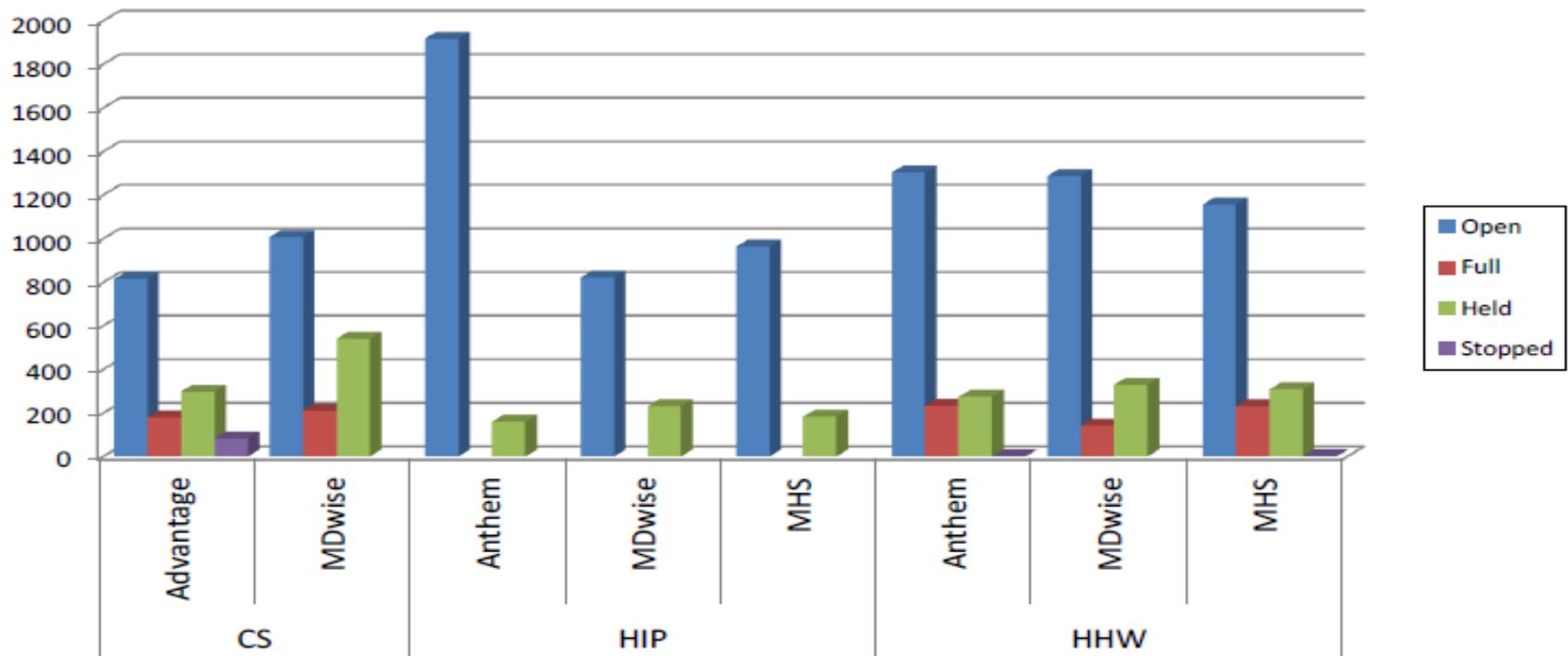

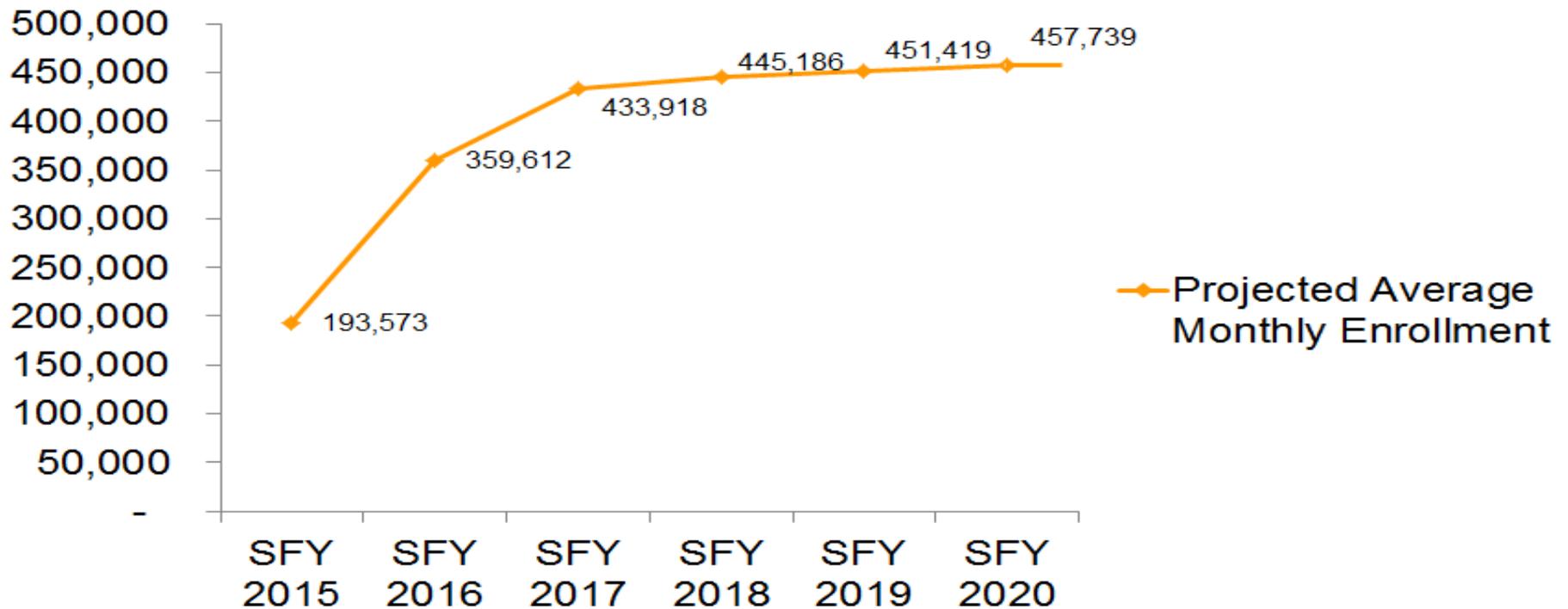
Care Select/HIP/Hoosier Healthwise Panel Status - June 2014





# Why Does It Matter

## Areas of Concern

- Do we have enough PMPs to manage influx of new members?
  - Do rural areas have access to PMPs?
  - HIP has 1000 fewer PMPs enrolled than Hoosier Healthwise
  - Even with 400000 new members, HIP would still be at a better ratio than HHW at approximately 100 to 1 with PMPs
- Mental Health providers
  - Stagnant growth over last ten years
  - Decrease in last five years
  - Increase in those utilizing services



# Areas of Concern

- Dental
  - Pediatric Dentist
  - Education issue
  - Rural communities
- Transportation
  - No real growth in last ten years with decrease in last five
  - Fewer providers offering non-emergency transportation



# Current Recruitment

- 2014 YTD 872 new enrollments with most being expanded group enrollments

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- Renewed focus to collaborate with Managed Care Entities to work in tandem
  - Increase in broad spectrum recruitment meetings
  - Planned joint recruitment efforts
  - Better information sharing
  - Streamline enrollment activities



# Initiatives Moving Forward

- Continued education throughout Indiana
  - Increase community involvement
  - More visits to smaller communities
  - Using hospitals as central point of contact
- Examine the role of mid-level providers
  - Should we enroll all APNs and PAs to increase PMP provider pool?
    - Bring Indiana current with Medicare policies
  - Review of mental health mid-levels to explore the possibility of expanding their roles
    - Examination of HSPP oversight and current billing rules and policies



## Initiatives Cont.

- Increased involvement with provider associations and organizations
  - Increase Indiana state employee presence at meetings
  - Seek feedback on publications, policies, and program updates
- Explore Partnerships with Colleges/Universities
  - Keep Indiana trained resources in Indiana
  - Educate future professionals earlier on Indiana Health Coverage Programs



## Initiatives Cont.

- Hospital Presumptive Eligibility
  - Education
  - Outreach
  - Enrollment
- Provider Workshops and Presentation
  - Increase in number
  - Spread out over more geographic locations
  - Restructured evaluations
  - Focus on areas of Indiana where greater need may exist
  - Evolving format
