

### Indiana's Home & Community-Based Services Spend Plan Provider and Workforce Impact

<u>Indiana's HCBS Spend Plan</u> outlines how FSSA is maximizing the one-time opportunity provided by Section 9817 of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to invest an estimated \$727M into the HCBS landscape through March 2025. A majority of Indiana's planned investments directly impact HCBS providers and the workforce.

#### \$131M Direct Service Workforce Investment Grant


**825 Providers:** To improve workforce retention, ensure quality of LTSS services, and support the well-being of the workforce and the individuals they serve
