# What We Expect if We Achieve our Vision

#### Short Term

- -decreased trips to the ED or UC
- -immediate access for non-emergent medical concerns via an easy to use telehealth application
- -better medical support to agencies and DSPs
- -documentation on treatment plans for agencies and individuals
- -improved care coordination with **PCPs**
- -improved satisfaction with the medical care individuals receive

# Long Term

Individuals with IDD and those that support them will have 24/7 access to quality medical care from clinicians that understand their specialized needs from their home setting.

The improved access will result in a better quality of life, decreased burden on their formal and informal care staff and foster community integration and independence.

The project will demonstrate there is a significant cost saving by employing a telehealth solution specially focused on individuals with IDD.

Early identification and adding addiional supports to complex cases will be the standard.

### What We Want to Avoid

Outcomes that may take away from the vision and will serve as "red flags" to consider course correction.

- -lack of engagement and under utilization of the service/solution
- -extremely complex cases that are not able to be managed virtually
- -misunderstanding and misuse of the services
- -pushback from established medical services to utilize the services
