State Officials to Discuss Health Indiana Plan Expansion at Community Hospital East

Indianapolis, IN—Last month, Governor Mike Pence announced HIP 2.0, a consumer-driven healthcare coverage program for low income adults that builds on Indiana’s history of providing incentives for members to take personal responsibility for their health. The governor used the original Healthy Indiana Plan as the basis to expand coverage to more low income Hoosiers. State officials will provide details about this proposal at a forum at Community Hospital East.

Who: FSSA Secretary Debra Minott will provide details on the Governor’s plan to expand the Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) to cover more than 350,000 Hoosiers.
