Contact the Indiana Department of Insurance for a list of approved potential NEMT carriers for Indiana

• Make appointment to meet with underwriters and request a review of the insured's risk.

90 days before insurance renewal date compile an operational history.

- Outline management experience
- Provide policy/procedure/description on hiring practices including,
 - Recruitment
 - Interview
 - References
 - Background checks
 - Driver's license check
- Provide policy/procedure/description training procedures and documentation of initial training and remedial or periodic training including,
 - Preventing or managing incidents with riders,
 - Managing unruly passengers
 - Reporting trips, passenger verification, etc.
 - Wheel chair securement training
 - Assisting special needs riders
- Provide policy/procedure/description and documentation of vehicle maintenance including,
 - Safety inspections
 - Preventative maintenance
 - Minimum of two years history
- Provide documentation of third party oversight, if applicable
 - Inspections of vehicles for contracted trips
 - Remediation of negative findings
 - Driver training and credentialing

No later than 60 days before renewal date meet with underwriters and provide the operational history.
