## What is SMES?

SMES are devices, controls, or appliances that enable individuals to increase their independence.

The following are approved SMES:

- Lift chair
- Medication dispensers
- Toileting/incontinence supplies
- Slip resistant socks
- Self help devices
- Strollers
- Voice active smart devices
- Interpreter service

## What is needed to provide SMES?

#### Must have:

Home Health Agency License or Home Medical Equipment Service Provider License Registered retail merchant certificate.

Please note that this this service requires a fingerprint background check through the Indiana State Police (ISP). This is needed prior to enrolling with the IHCP. For more information: <u>Instructions for</u> <u>Fingerprinting</u>

Please note that this service requires an application fee for the IHCP enrollment process. For more information: <u>Provider Enrollment Application Fee Site</u>. If paying the application fee will cause a financial hardship to you or your business, you may request an application fee waiver. To support your request for an application fee waiver, you should submit the following:

- Copies of bank statements, cash flow statements, tax returns or any other documentation demonstrating the financial status of your business
- Copies of any other outcomes of measures used to raise the application fee, such as bank loan requests, credit card withdrawals, or assistance from family or friends.
