What is the Indiana Pregnancy Promise Program?

The Indiana Pregnancy Promise Program is a free, voluntary program for pregnant Medicaid members who are or have been impacted by substance use disorders. The goals of the Pregnancy Promise Program are for participants to:

- Enter prenatal care
- Access treatment needed to achieve sustained recovery
- Receive ongoing support and follow-up care for the mother and infant during and after pregnancy
- Provide hope and set a strong foundation for the future
