EXECUTIVE ORDER __24~08

FOR:

DECLARING A DISASTER EMERGENCY IN GIBSON, POSEY & WARRICK COUNTIES DUE TO SEVERE WEATHER & TORNADIC ACTIVITY

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 10-14-3-12 provides that the Governor shall declare a disaster emergency by executive order if he determines a disaster involving widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property has occurred or is imminent;

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2024, severe weather and tornadic activity caused widespread and severe damage in Gibson and Posey counties, which was followed a few weeks later by severe weather and tornadic activity causing severe damage in Warrick County on July 30, 2024;

WHEREAS, in all three counties, the severe weather resulted in damage and destruction of homes, businesses, infrastructure, and other structures; loss of power; downing of trees and power lines; and damage to or closure of certain roads; and

WHEREAS, immediately following these weather events, state and local officials initiated emergency response activities along with damage assessments which took some time to complete and resulted in a finding that each event exceeds the threshold, and therefore qualifies, for public assistance through the State Disaster Relief Fund, IC § 10-14-4-7, and, accordingly, this executive order is being issued in connection with same;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby:

DECLARE that a state of disaster emergency exists in Gibson, Posey and Warrick counties, and, pursuant to Indiana Code § 10-14-3-12, shall continue for 30 days; and

ORDER the IDHS Executive Director to coordinate any and all necessary assistance with the appropriate federal, state, and local agencies.
