AFFORDABILITY

Governor Braun has made affordability a central focus of his administration by focusing on increased wages, delivering historic property tax reform, cutting income taxes, freezing college tuition for all state universities, appointing new leadership to the OUCC and three new commissioners to the IURC that will be ratepayer-focused, and transforming the healthcare industry to be more patient-driven.

These actions have helped stabilize household costs, but the work is not finished. Hoosiers have made clear that while wages are rising, expenses continue to outpace them. Governor Braun remains committed to addressing “kitchen table” issues in the 2026 legislative session and beyond.


HOUSING & HOMEOWNERSHIP

Homeownership remains central to the American Dream and a critical pathway to economic mobility. Yet for many Hoosiers, rising prices and limited housing supply have put that goal further out of reach. The challenge is not demand, but supply—**new housing is not being built fast enough** to meet the needs of growing communities.

Governor Braun supports a commonsense approach to housing affordability that focuses on **removing unnecessary and unpredictable regulations that increase costs and delay construction**. By modernizing and stabilizing housing regulations, the state can encourage **responsible growth, respect property rights, and restore affordability**—particularly for first-time buyers and working families.

ENERGY AFFORDABILITY

Energy costs have risen sharply over the past decade, creating a growing burden for families and businesses. Governor Braun believes affordability and reliability must go hand-in-hand. Working with the legislature, there is opportunity to take an approach that emphasizes **modernization of rate-setting practices, accountability for utilities, and expanded energy generation to meet future demand**.



HEALTH CARE AFFORDABILITY & ACCESS

Indiana's high health care costs remain a major driver of financial stress, with medical debt affecting a significant portion of Hoosier families. Governor Braun's health care agenda is centered on **restoring the patient as the primary decision-maker, increasing transparency, and fostering competition to lower costs.**

The administration supports a **comprehensive approach to medical debt**—preventing it through transparency and fair billing practices, while **protecting families from predatory collections**. At the same time, improving access to care, especially in rural communities, is essential to affordability. **Expanding training pipelines, strengthening workforce development, and improving care delivery models** will help ensure Hoosiers can access quality care close to home.

Improving health care quality is also critical to controlling costs. **Reducing administrative burdens on providers, modernizing prior authorization, and strengthening workforce standards** allow doctors to focus on patients—leading to better outcomes and more efficient care.

JOBS & WAGES

Economic development is about more than growth—it is about opportunity. Governor Braun's strategy focuses on creating high-paying jobs, empowering entrepreneurs, and ensuring that every region of the state can thrive. Under his leadership, Indiana has realigned its economic development efforts around regional collaboration, workforce upskilling, and entrepreneurship.

These reforms are delivering results. Incentivized jobs now pay higher wages at a lower cost to taxpayers, ensuring Hoosiers get more value for every dollar invested. Looking ahead, the Governor will continue to aggressively seek to grow the state, build a business environment that rewards innovation, support small businesses, and allow communities to shape their own economic future.



WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT & WAGE GROWTH

A justice system that fails to hold violent and repeat offenders accountable erodes public trust. Governor Braun **supports amending the constitution to allow for preventative detention** along with meaningful safeguards **focused on violent offenders.**

ADDRESSING HOMELESSNESS WITH COMPASSION & ORDER

Homelessness affects both vulnerable individuals and the broader community. Governor Braun supports a **compassionate approach that addresses root causes while maintaining public order and safety. Encouraging connections to services, supporting local solutions, and setting clear expectations for the use of public spaces** help protect individuals in crisis and the communities around them.
