FOR: PARDON

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS;

WHEREAS, COREY T. COOK, who has petitioned for a pardon, was convicted in Vigo County for auto theft after turning himself in for stealing a motorcycle in 1993, for which he was sentenced to a term of 18 months, all of which was suspended except for a 90-day period served in the Vigo County Jail; and

WHEREAS, except for this crime, which was committed at the age of 18, the petitioner has no criminal record; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner, who has maintained steady employment since 1995, is dedicated to his family and his job and has a reputation for donating time and financial support to those in need; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner is an active member of his local church and community and has numerous letters of support from his family and friends; and


WHEREAS, the petitioner has stated that he requested this pardon in order to remove the stigma of a felony conviction from his record and to receive the full benefits of citizenship; and

WHEREAS, the Parole Board, after careful investigation and examination of all the facts in this case, has recommended that this pardon be granted.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of said State, do hereby issue a pardon to COREY T. COOK.
