Welcome and Call to Order - Chair Teresa Lubbers

- a. Meeting called to order at 10:00am ET.

II. Roll Call of Cabinet Members

- a. P.J. McGrew called the roll for Workforce Cabinet members; a quorum was present.

V. New Business

a. Community Health and Ascend Partnership

- i. Stephanie Bothun from Ascend Indiana and Cabinet member Joyce Irwin from Community Health Network presented to the Cabinet regarding current needs in the healthcare field. Their presentation specifically focused on needs in the nursing and behavioral health fields and strategies Community Health has implemented to address workforce needs in these areas. Cabinet members discussed ways the Cabinet can help facilitate collaboration across the employer community, postsecondary institutions, and others to help address workforce pipeline needs in these areas on a statewide basis.

b. Discussion and Approval of Local Workforce Plans

- i. PJ presented the local workforce plans developed by the 12 regions. The local plans are a required step after the submission of the state workforce plan submitted under WIOA. PJ reviewed some goals of the state plan and then a summary of each local plan. Commissioner Lubbers, Commissioner Payne and Secretary Jenner commented on how it was encouraging to see

the focus on alignment in the plans and the focus on other areas the GWC has been helping lead efforts around.

1. Local plans underwent an initial review by Department of Workforce Development staff and a recommendation was made to the Cabinet. The recommendation made by DWD was for 8 plans to receive full approval and 4 to receive conditional approval. PJ asked for a motion to be made to vote on the recommendation. A motion was made by Joyce Irwin and seconded by President Ellspermann.
