Skillful Indiana: Coaching Initiative



Why should we care about Indiana's adult career coaching system?

- As the economy rapidly changes and occupations shift, career coaches are at the front lines, translating labor market information, specific employer needs, and the landscape of training opportunities to guide workers on their next steps- no matter what stage of their life or career.
- Even as new technologies are introduced, job seekers and incumbent workers will
 continue to turn to career coaches at their local community college, public workforce
 center, staffing agency, and other organizations for guidance on the jobs to take and what
 is needed to upskill.

What impact does the Skillful IN Coaching initiative seek to achieve?

Given their important role in the ecosystem, Skillful Indiana's Coaching initiative will:

- Break down silos in the career coaching among components of the larger workforce ecosystem (public workforce centers, higher education, nonprofits, employers, and staffing agencies)
- Upskill coaches so they can prepare job seekers for the future of work
- Raise the profile of career coaching
- Ultimately, place more job seekers on better pathways by advancing and supporting the adult career coaching and navigation system

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GOVERNOR'S COACHING CORPS (GCC)

An annual leadership program in which Indiana's most talented career coaches develop innovative practices and technologies to support career services in an increasingly digital economy, while advancing their professional development and sharing best practices with their peers.
