- Qualified to provide ASL progress monitoring
- ✓ Deaf adult who is native user of ASL
- ✓ ASL linguistic background
- ✓ Teacher license/ certification
- Direct communication with the student without use of an interpreter

Environment

- Not visually or auditorily distracting
- Good lighting; not in front of windows
- Present information at eye level of student
