Executive Order

PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, lung cancer accounts for more Hoosier deaths than breast, colorectal and prostate cancers combined; and
- WHEREAS, the lung cancer five-year survival rate is lower than that of many other leading cancers with available screenings; and
- WHEREAS, early detection of lung cancer can dramatically improve survival rates; and
- WHEREAS, annual screening for lung cancer is recommended for adults aged 50 to 80 years who have a 20 pack-year smoking history and currently smoke or have quit within the past 15 years; and
- WHEREAS, making lung cancer a public health priority supports Hoosier lung cancer patients, those at risk for the disease and those in our communities who are affected by lung cancer;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim November 9, 2024 as

LUNG CANCER SCREENING DAY

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
