## REQUIREMENTS TO OBTAIN A FIRST-TIME INDIANA RADIOLOGY LICENSE / CERTIFICATE

The Indiana Department of Health (IDOH), Division of Radiology and Weights & Measures, issues radiology permits, licenses, and certificates for eight categories. Indiana does not have reciprocity with other states. A permit, license or certificate from another state is not accepted. Permits are required to complete clinical training in Indiana. They are issued to individuals when they enroll in an approved radiography education program. After individuals complete the approved education program, clinical training (with an active permit), and pass an approved exam, they may apply for a license/certificate.

## To obtain a first-time Indiana Cardiac Catheterization Radiographer Certificate, individuals must complete the following:

- Graduate from an IDOH-approved radiography education program for cardiac catheterization. Current programs are at this direct link: <u>Cardiac Catheterization</u>.
   AND
- Complete clinical training (proficiency certification) after obtaining an active provisional permit for
  cardiac catheterization radiography. The clinical training form (<u>Application for Proficiency</u>
  <u>Certification for Limited Radiographer</u>) must be completed by the program director of the approved
  radiography education program or by the licensed practitioner, who oversaw the clinical training while
  the provisional permit was active.
  AND
- Pass approved cardiac catheterization limited radiology exam AND
- Apply for Cardiac Catheterization certificate online or by mail (details are below and at <a href="https://www.in.gov/health/cshcr/medical-radiology-services/">https://www.in.gov/health/cshcr/medical-radiology-services/</a>)
  - To apply for a certificate online, go to <a href="mylicense.in.gov">mylicense.in.gov</a>. Login or create your login credentials using the "Register for an Access Indiana Account" option. Select "Radiology", the license type, and application. It is required to upload the completed clinical training form, diploma / certificate of completion from an approved educational program, and proof of passing an approved exam. For questions about the documents, contact the program director of the education program.
  - To apply for a certificate by mail, print and complete the license application (<u>Application for Radiology License</u>) and mail it with a check or money order for \$60 to the address on the form. To process the Cardiac Catheterization certificate, the IDOH must receive copies of the completed clinical training form, diploma / certificate of completion from an approved educational program, and proof of passing an approved exam. All documents can be mailed together with the license application and payment. For questions about the documents, contact the program director of the education program.
