REQUIREMENTS TO OBTAIN A FIRST-TIME INDIANA RADIOLOGY LICENSE / CERTIFICATE

The Indiana Department of Health (IDOH), Division of Radiology and Weights & Measures, issues radiology permits, licenses, and certificates for eight categories. Indiana does not have reciprocity with other states. A permit, license or certificate from another state is not accepted. Permits are required to complete clinical training in Indiana. They are issued to individuals when they enroll in an approved radiography education program. After individuals complete the approved education program, clinical training (with an active permit), and pass an approved exam, they may apply for a license/certificate.

To obtain a first-time Indiana Dental Radiographer License, individuals must complete the following:

- Graduate from a CODA-accredited program in radiography for dental assistants or graduate from an IDOH-approved radiography education program for dental assistants.

AND

- Complete clinical training (proficiency certification).
 - If attending a CODA-accredited program, an active <u>student</u> permit for dental radiography is required to do clinical training in Indiana.
 - If attending an IDOH-approved program, an active <u>provisional</u> permit for dental radiography is required to do clinical training in Indiana.
 - The clinical training form (<u>Application for Proficiency Certification for Limited Radiographer</u>) is only required for individuals who attended the IDOH-approved programs and must be completed by the program director of the IDOH-approved program or by the licensed practitioner, who oversaw the clinical training while the provisional permit was active.

AND

- Pass Dental Assisting National Board (DANB) Radiation Health and Safety (RHS) exam OR
 - Pass Dental Assisting National Board (DANB) Certified Dental Assistant (CDA) exam AND
- Apply for Dental Radiographer license by mail (details are below and at https://www.in.gov/health/cshcr/medical-radiology-services/)
 - After completing a CODA-accredited program, IDOH requires proof of completing the education program and passing the DANB RHS or CDA exam.
 OR
 - o **After completing an IDOH-approved program**, IDOH requires proof of completing the education program, clinical training, and passing the exam.
 - o To apply for a Dental Radiographer license:
 - Print and complete the license application (<u>Application for Radiology License</u>) and mail it with a check or money order for \$60 to the address on the form, along with these items:
 - Copy of diploma / certificate of completion from approved educational program
 - Proof of passing the DANB RHS or CDA exam
 - Copy of completed clinical training form (<u>Application for Proficiency</u> <u>Certification for Limited Radiographer</u>), if completed an IDOH-approved program
