To obtain a first-time Indiana Radiation Therapist license, individuals must complete the following:

Graduate from an approved ARRT radiation therapy program. Current programs are at this link:

 (Students are required to have an active student permit to complete clinical training in Indiana.)

AND

- Pass the ARRT exam for radiation therapy AND
- Be currently certified and registered by the ARRT with credentials RT(T)
 AND
- Apply for Radiation Therapist license online at this link: <u>mylicense.in.gov</u>. Or print, complete, and mail license application (<u>Application for Radiology License</u>) and check/money order for \$60 to address on form.
