## To obtain an Indiana Radiologic Technologist license, individuals must complete the following:

- Graduate from an approved ARRT radiography program. Current programs are at this link: <u>https://www.arrt.org/pages/about-the-profession/learn-about-the-profession/recognized-educational-programs</u>. (Students are required to have an active student permit to complete clinical training in Indiana.)
  - AND
- Pass the ARRT exam for radiography AND
- Be currently certified and registered by the ARRT with credentials RT(R) AND
- Apply for Radiologic Technologist license online at <u>mylicense.in.gov</u>. Or print, complete, and mail license application (<u>Application for Radiology License</u>) and check/money order for \$60 to address on form.
