**Subject:** Summary/Response to Comment, Rules for Readoption, LSA#24-588

The Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) requested public comment on rules to be readopted from September 10 through October 10, 2025 assigned LSA#24-588 and available at: [410 24-588 | IARP](#). One comment was received pertaining to 410 IAC 38, INSPECTION AND CLEANUP OF PROPERTY CONTAMINATED WITH CHEMICALS USED IN THE ILLEGAL MANUFACTURE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE. The comment received and the response to the comment by IDOH is summarized as follows:

*A comment was received requesting the Indiana Department of Health adopt the American National Standard's Institute/Institute of Inspection, Cleaning, and Restoration Certification (ANSI/IICRC) S900 Standard to address evolving risks presented by illicit drug use, manufacturing and contamination, especially with the growing prevalence of fentanyl.*

*Response:* While the rule readoption process does not allow for any changes, IDOH will carefully consider adopting the ANSI/IICRC S900 standard when the subject rule is revised in the future as it may provide a universally recognized standard for the decontamination of properties affected by the manufacture of illicit drugs. Additionally, the ANSI/IICRC S900 standard also applies to sites contaminated by the use of illicit drugs. Currently, IDOH's legislative authority for the promulgation of such regulations only applies to sites contaminated by the *manufacturing* of illicit drugs and not the use of these drugs.
