Condition Name:

**Hepatitis, viral, Type C
(acute and chronic)**

Condition Name in NBS:

- **Hepatitis C, acute**
- **Hepatitis C Virus Infection, past or present**

Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Positive Anti-HCV (including rapid tests)
- Nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT, such as PCR) for hepatitis C virus RNA
- HCV Genotype test

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, epidemiologic, pregnancy status, lab report, and treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report
- Available information on patient symptoms, including jaundice

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results (Hepatic Panel and/or Comprehensive Metabolic Panel)
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history
