

## ALLOWABLE USES OF RYAN WHITE PART B FUNDS

### BACKGROUND:

To assure the costs of treatment of RW are authorized by RWHAP statute (PHS 2612), and consistent with Cost Principles and Policy Clarification Notice (PCN) #16-02.

### POLICY:

For an allowable charge to be posted to the Ryan White Part B grant, the cost must be incurred during the award period and only to support administration and Core medical and Support services that are needed by individuals with HIV/AIDS.

### DOCUMENTATION:

Budgets, Service expenses as reported for reimbursement at ISDH, and notes in the client records that document use of funds according to PIN 16-02.

### GUIDANCE:

In every instance, the HIV/AIDS Bureau (HAB) expects that services supported with Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP) funds will fall within the following legislatively-defined range of services:

**Core medical services** are a set of essential direct health care services provided to persons living with HIV/AIDS. Core services include:

1. Outpatient and Ambulatory Health Services
2. AIDS Drug Assistance Program Treatments
3. AIDS Pharmaceutical Assistance
4. Oral Health
5. Early Intervention Services (EIS)
6. Health Insurance Premium and Cost Sharing Assistance for Low-Income Individuals
7. Home and Community-Based Health Services
8. Home Health Care Hospice Services Housing
9. Medical Case Management, including Treatment Adherence Services
10. Medical Nutrition Therapy
11. Hospice
12. Mental Health
13. Substance Abuse Outpatient Care Substance Abuse Services (residential)

**Support services** are a set of services needed to achieve medical outcome that affect the HIV-related clinical status of a person living with HIV/AIDS. Support services include:

1. Child Care Services
2. Emergency Financial Assistance

3. Food Bank/Home Delivered Meals
4. Health Education/Risk Reduction
5. Housing
6. Other Professional Services
7. Linguistic

12. Referral for Health Care and Support Services
13. Rehabilitation Services
14. Respite Care
15. Substance Abuse Outpatient Care Substance Abuse Services (residential)

**EXCEPTIONS:**

No exceptions for allowability of services funded by Ryan White or rebate funding.
