Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- *Bacillus anthracis* identified in cell culture, immunohistochemical staining, serology, LRN-validated polymerase chain reaction, or LF mass spectrometry.

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Contact the Vector-Borne and Zoonotic Disease Program (business hours) or the Epidemiologist On-Call (after hours) immediately to report.
- Complete Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment Information sections within the NBS morbidity report.

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records (if available) including outpatient office visits, specialty consults, and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries.
- Recent travel history and potential environmental, food, animal or lab exposures
- Name and contact information of follow up provider should be listed in the Administrative Comments section of the morbidity report.
