## Condition Name:

## Reporting Timeframe:

**Within One Working Day**

## TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

## Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Serum total antibody titers to *Brucella spp.* by standard tube agglutination testing (SAT) or *Brucella* microagglutination testing (BMAT), or detection of *Brucella spp.* DNA by PCR or bacterial isolation of *Brucella spp.*

## Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

## Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records (if available) including outpatient office visits, specialty consults and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries
- Travel history and known animal exposures
- Name and contact information of follow-up provider should be listed in the administrative comments section of the morbidity report
