Condition Name:

Ehrlichiosis

Condition Name in NBS:

- Ehrlichiosis, chaffeensis
- Ehrlichiosis, ewingii
- Ehrlichiosis/Anaplasmosis, undetermined

Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Ehrlichia species in cell culture, immunohistochemical methods, PCR, IFA.

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment Information sections within the NBS morbidity report.

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records including outpatient office visits, specialty consultations, and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries, recent travel history.
- Name and contact information of follow up provider should be listed in the Administrative Comments section of the morbidity report.
