**Condition Name:**  
**Hepatitis, viral, Type A**

**Condition Name in NBS:**  
**Hepatitis A, acute**

**Reporting Timeframe:**  
**Within One Working Day**

## TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

## Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Immunoglobulin M (IgM) antibody to hepatitis A virus (anti-HAV) positive
- Nucleic acid amplification test (NAAT, such as PCR) for hepatitis A virus RNA

## Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report
- Available information on patient symptoms

## Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results (Hepatic Panel and/or Comprehensive Metabolic Panel)
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history, including travel
