Condition Name:

**Paratyphoid fever, cases
and carriers**

Condition Name in NBS:

**Paratyphoid Fever (*S. enteritica*
serotypes A/B/C)**

Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- *Salmonella enterica* serotypes Paratyphi A, B (tartrate negative), and C detected by culture or culture-independent diagnostic testing (CIDT)
- Antimicrobial susceptibility testing

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history, including travel
