## Condition Name:

## Reporting Timeframe:

**Within One Working Day**

## TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

## Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Report to a major hospital emergency department for initial dose of human rabies immune globulin (HRIG) and rabies vaccine due to availability of product.

## Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report.

## Additional Documentation to Include

Additional doses of the vaccine may be administered in a smaller clinic

- Day 1—HRIG + rabies vaccine
- Day 3— Rabies vaccine
- Day 7— Rabies vaccine
- Day 14— Rabies vaccine
