

When to Review and Update a Class B Investigation

Review Class B Investigation in NBS when **1) Email is received from** IDOH of an opened Class B investigation, **and/or 2) Update** Class B investigation when patient has been evaluated, disposition complete, and/or diagnosed with LTBI or TB disease and treatment therapy initiated/completed.

To review a Class B Investigation in NBS:

- Locate the patient record by using *Patient Search*
- Select the *Summary* tab on the patient record
- Select *Class B* under *Open Investigations*
- Select *Supplemental Info* tab for attachments and notes
- Select *Edit* to update variables in the investigation

Variable Guidance

If evaluation was not initiated or initiated not completed, select the appropriate variables from the drop-down menu in the TB Workup and Evaluation Disposition in the U.S.

Submitting a Notification

- Open Class B Investigation from patient record
- Complete TB Workup and Evaluation Disposition in U.S. sections
- Select *Create Notification*
- If the required information and disposition are complete, IDOH TB RNC approves the notification
- If required information or disposition is missing, IDOH TB RNC rejects the notification with comments. LHD PHN views the comments under Rejected Notifications Queue and makes corrections/updates as needed before resubmitting notification.

Required Variables for Notification

- U.S. Evaluation - TB Testing
- U.S. Evaluation - Imaging
- U.S. Review of Pre-Immigration/I-693 Treatment
- U.S. Microscopy/Bacteriology
- U.S. Evaluation Disposition
