Running an Invalid Dose Report

Why Would I Run an Invalid Dose Report?

To assist Providers in assessing vaccine doses given outside the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommendations. The provides an opportunity to determine, if any training needs are required for the correct dosing, spacing, and timing of vaccinations.

How Can I Run an Invalid Doses Report?

1. Log into CHIRP, Select Reports, and Report Module.




2. Under the Quality section, select, Vaccination Data Quality.

3. Enter a Vaccination Date Range or Birth Date Range.



4. Select your Organization or VFC PIN from the dropdown box.


5. Select "Create Report".

6. Once the report has been created click on the "**details**" tab, next to the Organization/Facility Name.



Note: This will generate a more in depth report (including patient name, SIIS number, vaccination date, and an explanation as to why the dose was invalid).
