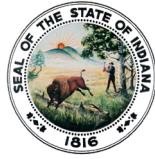

Re: Annual Radon Reports

- As per 410 IAC 5.1-28(f), all Indiana Licensed Primary Testers, Laboratories, and Mitigators are required to report all radon activity to IDOH on a form approved by IDOH. All reports are due on January 31st for data from the previous calendar year (e.g. 2021 testing/mitigation data is due on January 31st, 2022). **Failure to report will result in license suspension.**
- Mitigation and testing data must be reported on the appropriate spreadsheets. If your company has multiple professionals in the same discipline, you may report them all on one spreadsheet, but you **must clearly indicate which professional performed the work at each property.** This is necessary for auditing purposes.
- Annual reports and any questions about reporting should be emailed to Phil Waters (pwaters@isdh.in.gov). Data must be reported using the Excel spreadsheets provided on the [IDOH website](#). Reports must be provided in Excel format. Do not save as a PDF and email it back.
