Re: Annual Radon Reports

- As per 410 IAC 5.1-28(f), all Indiana Licensed Primary Testers and Mitigators are required to report all radon activity to IDOH on a form approved by IDOH. All reports are due on January 31st for data from the previous calendar year (e.g., 2021 testing/mitigation data is due on January 31st, 2022). **Failure to report will result in license suspension.**
- Annual reporting should be uploaded in the radon reporting portal accessed through the Indiana Department of Health Gateway:
<https://gateway.isdh.in.gov/Gateway/SignIn.aspx>
- **Mitigation and testing data MUST be reported on the State-provided Excel spreadsheet downloaded from the radon reporting portal.** No other document is acceptable.
- If your company has multiple professionals in the same discipline, you may report them all on one spreadsheet, but you **must clearly indicate which professional performed the work at each property.** This is necessary for auditing purposes.
