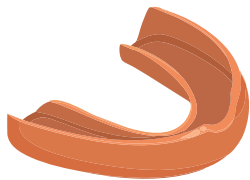


Protect Your Smile: Mouth Guards and Safety

Keeping your child's mouth safe is important, especially during sports and outdoor play!



What is a Mouth Guard?

A **mouth guard** is a soft cover you wear over your teeth. It helps protect your teeth, mouth, and jaw from getting hurt.

When to Wear One

- During sports where you might fall, get bumped, or collide with others
 - » Soccer, baseball, football, basketball, gymnastics, taekwondo, martial arts, etc.
- Riding battery-powered scooters or bikes
- Skateboarding or rollerblading



Why Mouth Guards Matter

Children are **60 times** more likely to hurt their teeth without one. Mouth guards prevent:

- Broken teeth
- Cuts on lips or gums
- Jaw pain
- Damage to braces
