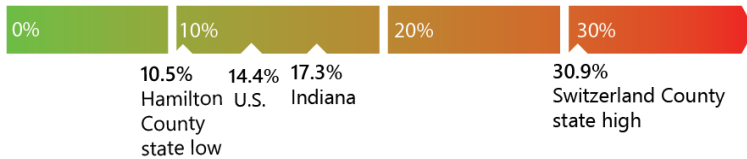

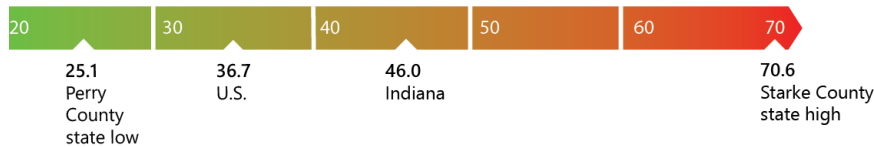

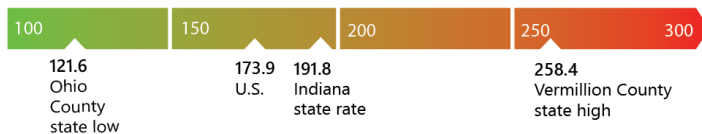
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **21.5%**



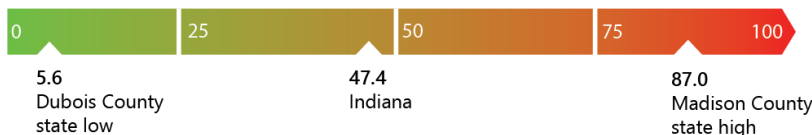
 **Lung cancer deaths** **45.0**
