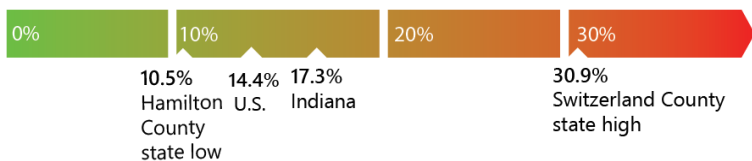

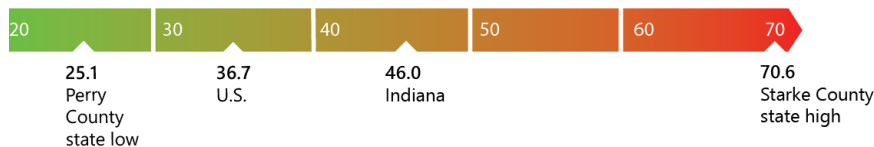

Tobacco and Health in Harrison County

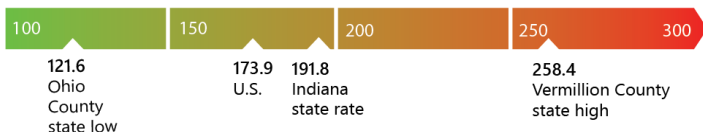
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **23.4%**



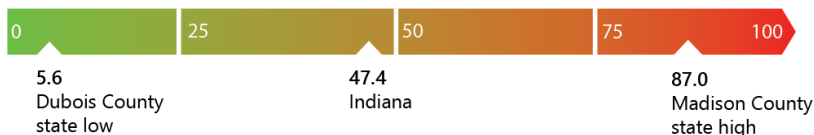
 **Lung cancer deaths** **48.5**
