## Indiana's Smoke Free Air Laws

Indiana's statewide smoke free air law, House Enrolled Act 1149, took effect July 1, 2012. In addition, 47 communities in Indiana are covered by a local smoke free air law. 28 communities plus the Indianapolis International Airport have passed a smoke free air law that includes non-hospitality workplaces, restaurants, and bars.

22 communities include membership clubs in their laws and 2 communities include gaming facilities.
