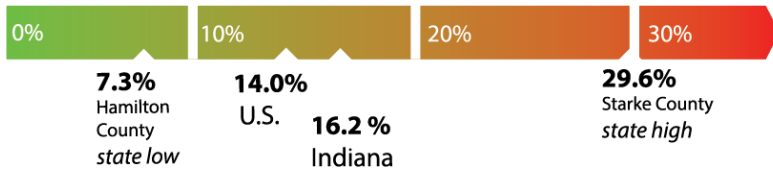


The state of tobacco control in Brown County

Tobacco and Health in Brown County

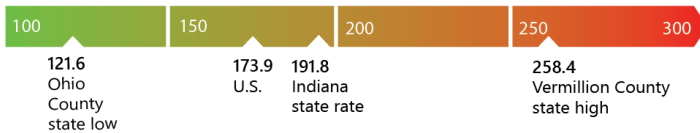
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **19.2%**



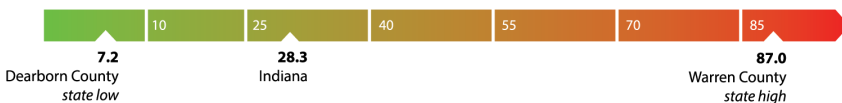
