

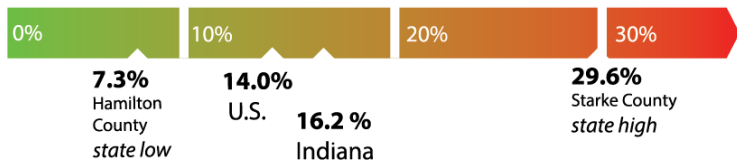

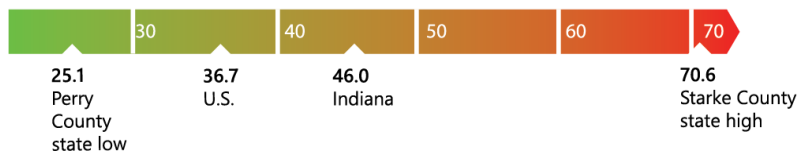

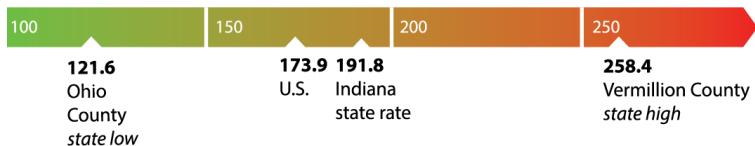
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **24.1%**



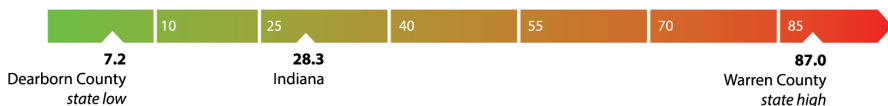
 **Lung cancer deaths** **56.6**
