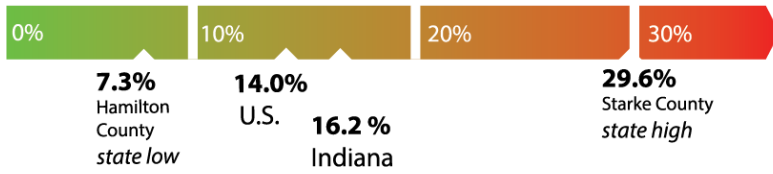


The state of tobacco control in Fountain County

Tobacco and Health in Fountain County

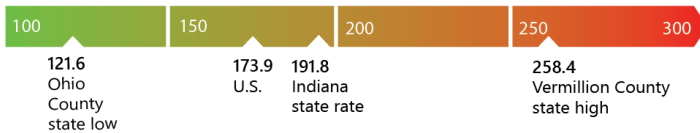
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **19.1%**



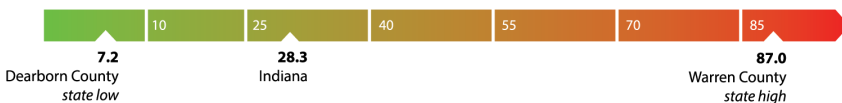
 **Lung cancer deaths** **49.5**
